The Student Advisory Council (SAC) is run by students and each student has an equal say and an equal vote. Every credit-earning student at MCAD is automatically a member of SAC - all it takes to be a full-fledged participant is to show up!

The Executive Committee is the body responsible for running SAC. It is comprised of one student from each department (listed below) who serves a one-year term. Each rep also contributes to department town hall meetings mediated by their Department Chair once per semester.

The Student Advisory Council is allotted funds each semester for student activities and programs. These funds come from the student activities portion of tuition. Written proposals for funding must be submitted prior to meetings and will be voted on by all present. Voting for all funding proposals will occur two weeks following presentation/submission of the proposal. (In special cases it is occasionally possible to waive the waiting period due to timing.)

Make a proposal. Have an idea for something that would be worthwhile here at MCAD but don't have the means to pull it off? SAC funds events and programs that are requested by individual students—as long as they are open to all MCAD students or at least beneficial to a substantial group of students. The Student Advisory Council's funds and influence are intended to be utilized by all students and all students are urged to participate in meetings, request funding, initiate programs, and develop resolutions and recommendations to the College Administration. Submit a SAC Proposal form in advance of the meeting and copies will be made for you.



Express your views, your concerns, your goals, get involved, propose improvements, engage socially, educationally, democratically.
