

Foundation Studies Merit Scholarship Awards 2016

Submission Deadline: On the Merits Server by 1:00 p.m. – Wednesday, March 28

Awards	MCAD Foundation Merit Scholarship Five awards, in the amount of \$2,000 each, will be granted to eligible students.
Eligibility to Apply	In order to be eligible to apply for Foundation Merit Scholarship Awards, you must have a 3.0 GPA and be a current student who either has less than 30 credits or who has not yet declared a major.
Eligibility to Receive	<p>In order to be eligible to receive a Foundation Merit Scholarship Award, you must be a full-time student for the Fall 2016 semester. If you are enrolled in less than 12 credits for Fall 2016, you will not receive a Merit Award.</p> <p>If you receive a Merit Scholarship Award in another department, you will NOT be eligible to receive a Foundation Merit Scholarship Award.</p>
Sign up	<p>A sign up sheet will be posted outside of the Academic Affairs office (Main 348)</p> <p>Sign up from February 8 – 22</p> <p>Deadline to sign up is February 22 by 1 pm.</p>
Written materials	Prepare a one-paragraph written statement of your educational goals and a one-page list of submitted works. On the list please identify each work with: medium, dimensions of original, and course the piece was completed in.
Submit digital files	<p>Submit a maximum of 20 pieces of your best creative work to the MCAD Merits Server. Please label your folder “last name, first name”. Jpeg files should not exceed 1 MB. Films should not exceed 5 minutes in length and be submitted via web link. Submit websites as URL addresses. Submitted work must be from Foundation classes.</p> <p>To access the Merits Server:</p> <p>*Submission deadline is Monday, March 28, 8 a.m.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. *Name your folder, “Last Name, First Name”2.
