LETTER OF AGREEMENT – FULL-TIME FACULTY

WHEREAS, Minneapolis College of Art and Design (the "Employer") and the Service Employees International Union Local 284 (the "Union") have entered into a collective bargaining agreement (the "Agreement") which governs the terms and conditions of employment for the members of the full-time faculty bargaining unit during the period January 1, 2023 through August 15, 2026; and

WHEREAS, during the collective bargaining which produced the Agreement the Employer and the Union also agreed to provide a cash bonus to certain full-time faculty.

NOW THEREFORE, the Employer and the Union agree to the following:

- 1. The Employer will provide a cash bonus of \$1,750.00 (the "Cash Bonus") to full-time faculty who are considered "Year 5" professors as of January 1, 2023. Faculty who are considered "Year 5" professors as of January 1, 2023 are listed on the employee list attached hereto as Attachment A.
- 2. A Faculty Member must be listed on Attachment A and must be employed on August 16, 2025 to teach in the 2025-2026 academic year to receive the Cash Bonus.
- 3. The Cash Bonus shall be included in the first paycheck of the 2025–2026 academic year. All regular payroll taxes will be withheld from the Cash Bonus.
