Faculty: Intro to Monotype Printmaking

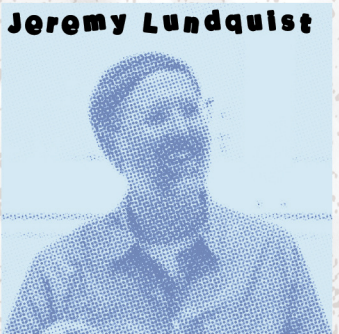
Michelle Lee Lagerroos works as a designer by day and a screenprinter and printmaking instructor by night.

Faculty: Intaglio, Photo Processes in Printmaking

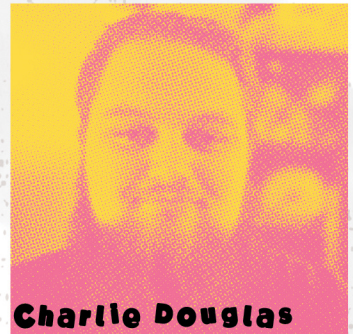

Graduate Assitant

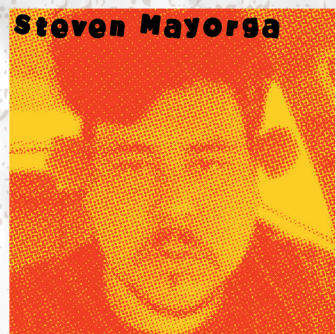

Graduate Assistant

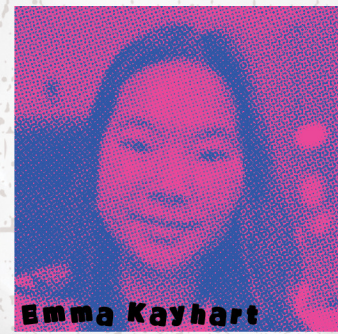

GTA, Dimensional Paper

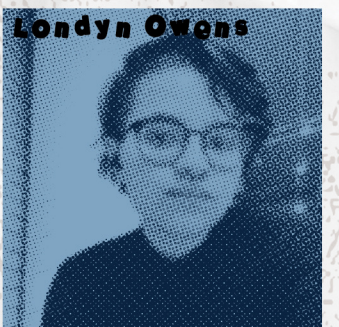
