FERPA Guidelines for MCAD Employees Records Office

MCAD complies with the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974 (FERPA). This federal law requires colleges and universities to maintain the privacy of student educational records.

MCAD designates certain information about its students as directory information and may release this to any person or organization in compliance with FERPA, as amended. See below for a list of directory information. MCAD may choose not to disclose information that has been designated as directory information, at its discretion.

A student can prevent disclosure of their directory information by notifying the Registrar in writing that they do not want such information to be released.

All other information in personal files or transcripts is restricted and will be released only to MCAD officials who have legitimate educational interest, or to other designated individuals with the written consent of the student.

Confidential information includes a student's financial aid information, academic standing, grades, grade point average and class schedule. See below for a list of non-directory information.

This restriction applies, but is not limited to, parents, spouse or a sponsor. Students may, at their discretion, grant MCAD permission to release information about their record to a parent or other individual by submitting a FERPA permission form via myMCAD.

What types of information may be released without student consent?

YES Directory/public information which may be released.	NO Information that is restricted and may only be released to eligible parties.
