

Free Continuing Education Class(es) for Degree Students

What:

May 2020 graduates will be able to take 2 free Continuing Education (CE) courses over a two year period. Students who were enrolled at MCAD during spring semester, 2020 but have not yet graduated will be able to take 1 free CE course over a two year period. This includes MFA and MA students.

When:

Courses starting Fall 2020 will be eligible. The period for the free classes will last from Fall 2020 through Summer 2022.

How:

There will be a one week window prior to CE course registration opening up to the general public during which students in this group may contact the CE office at continuing_education@mcad.edu or by calling (612) 874-3765 to register.

If students contact the CE office after this early registration period, they may register for the free course provided there is still space available. If the class is full they may elect to join the waitlist and utilize the 75% alumni discount.

Policies:

- Free classes may be taken on a noncredit basis.
- Students may take a class for credit by paying an additional fee. However, the credits will not count towards the student's degree.
- Students/alumni will pay any necessary materials and facilities fee.
- Non-attendance at the class is not considered dropping the class. Unless the student officially drops the class by contacting the CE office, the class will count as one of the free classes, whether or not the student attended.
