Each semester the student and mentor determine its content, which is summarized in a Learning Contract in context with the student Long Range Learning Plan. Students work one-on-one with their mentor in the advancement of studio work, studio research, and professional practice. Studio Output/ Production – 70%

The largest part of the 9 credits should be studio output and production. This quantitative amount of production is determined between mentor and student.

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Studio Research & Professional Practice - 20%

Studio Research

The student is responsible to collect and prioritize readings and visuals to encourage and support their studio practice. This research can include but is not limited to written and visual references, historical and contemporary theory and practitioners in support of their studio work. Students should consider auditing classes in support of technical and academic skills.

Professional Practice

Professional Practice is essential for student development. Students are required to attend gallery openings, museums and lectures. Students are encouraged to attend conferences, curate exhibitions

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Weekly Meetings - 10%

The student and mentor will meet every week for an hour minimum, in the student's studio or appropriate location. This structure allows the student and mentor to have discussions, set weekly goals and assess progress.
