## Safety Procedures



### **NO food and drink in the shop!**

Why ?

- Food/drink may be contaminated by chemicals being used in the shop space.
- Food/drink might be spilled on the equipment and/or peoples' projects.
- It cuts down on the clutter and trash in the shop.

### **Dressing Appropriately for the Shop**

#### WOODS SECTIONS

##### **Required:**

- MUST wear closed toe shoes
- MUST wear safety glasses
- NO dangling jewelry (bracelets, necklaces, rings, tails, etc.)
- Tie back long hair
- NO personal stereos or headphones

##### **Recommended:**

- hearing protection
- apron
- respirator/dust mask

#### METALS SECTION

##### **Required:**

- Gloves (cotton or leather)
- Hearing Protection (available in shop office)
- Cotton or Wool** clothing (synthetic blends are a fire hazard)
- Long sleeved jacket when welding (available in shop)
- MUST wear long pants/jeans
- MUST wear closed toe (leather or equally durable) shoes
- MUST wear safety glasses
- NO dangling jewelry (bracelets, necklaces, rings, tails, etc.)
- Tie back long hair
- NO personal stereos or headphones

##### **Recommended:**

- apron
- respirator/dust mask
- hat or bandana when welding
