STUDENT STUDIOS - FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Who oversees the studios?

- The Exhibition & Studio Services Department assigns and monitors all studios on campus.

Am I eligible for a studio?

- You **MUST** have a cumulative of 30 credits or more (sophomore status or higher).
- You **MUST** be registered for a minimum of 12 credits for each semester (full time status).
- You **MUST** have a declared major.

**If you have an accommodation through the Learning Center, you may be eligible for a studio assignment even if you do not meet all of our eligibility criteria.

When can I apply for a studio?

- Studio Applications for the following academic year are available from mid-March through the beginning of May. Applications close the last day of school.
- If you missed the deadline, please reach out to ESS via email at exhibition_studio_services@mcad.edu and you will be added to the waitlist.

Can transfer students apply to a studio?

- If you meet the above eligibility requirements you can apply for a studio.
- If you are a transfer student who missed the deadline or are enrolling at semester, please reach out to ESS via email at exhibition_studio_services@mcad.edu as soon as possible.

 - 120 Expansion Studios
 - Location: 1st floor, behind the Cutting Room
 - 224 Design Studios
 - Location: 2nd floor, between Gallery 235 & Gallery 215
 - 350 Painting Studios
 - Location: 3rd floor, near Academic Affairs Office
