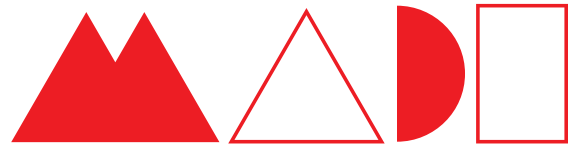
GUIDELINES FOR SUBMISSION

Made at MCAD is an annual juried all-student exhibition. The exhibition is open to all current MCAD students (all degrees and all divisions). Work submitted must have been made while the applicant was enrolled as a student at MCAD. Any medium is acceptable, including time-based works (e.g. film, video, websites, and animation).

- + Each student can submit up to three individual/collaborative works or one series up to eight pieces.
- + There is no size limit, but students are advised to contact the Gallery in advance if submitting excessively large or difficult-to-install work. Artwork does not need to be framed.
- + Gallery staff can work with students to hang work with glass, tape, and/or magnets if desired.
- + If submitting installation work, submit documentation of the work that best represents your concept on a CD or USB. Samples of film, video, and animation should be two minutes in length.
- + No artist statement necessary.
- + Please note that departmental Merit Award reviews might overlap with the jurying process and the exhibition. Artwork installed on March 8 or 9 when the jurors are on campus can be submitted—please provide image and location of artwork. However, if artwork is accepted, once it is installed for *Made at MCAD* it cannot be removed from the exhibition. Please plan accordingly.

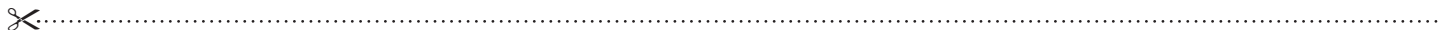
To submit, bring your work to the Main Gallery on Wednesday, March 7, 9:00 a.m.–7:00 p.m.

Fill out and attach the identification tags to the back of each work. Artists with works accepted for the exhibition will be notified via email no later than 10:00 a.m. on Friday, March 9. Work not accepted must be picked up from the Main Gallery no later than Saturday, March 10. If not retrieved, the Gallery cannot be responsible for the safekeeping of the works.

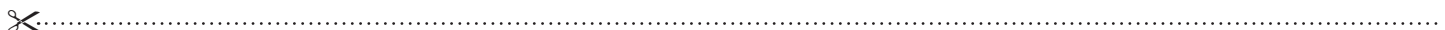
