Awards	<b>MCAD Foundation Merit Scholarship</b> Three awards, in the amount of \$2,000 each, will be granted to eligible students.
	<b>Hearst Foundation Merit Scholarship</b> Two awards, in the amount of \$2,000 each, will be granted to eligible students.
Eligibility to Apply	In order to be eligible to apply for Foundation Merit Scholarship Awards, you must have a 3.0 GPA and be a current student who either has less than 30 credits or who has not yet declared a major.
Eligibility to Receive	In order to be eligible to receive a Foundation Merit Scholarship Award, you must be a full-time student for the Fall 2021 semester. If you are enrolled in less than 12 credits for Fall 2021, you will not receive a Merit Award.
	If you receive a Merit Scholarship Award in another department, you will NOT be eligible to receive a Foundation Merit Scholarship Award.

## Server submission

All work will be viewed virtually. There will be no physical installations. Student work must be uploaded to the Merit server by Wednesday, March 24 at 5 PM Please follow the archiving standard on the intranet. <u>FIND THEM HERE</u>

- 3. Locate the FOUNDATIONS folder and drop your submission.

## What to Submit

Written materials

Prepare a one-paragraph written statement of your educational goals and a one-page list of submitted works. On the list, please identify each work with: medium, dimensions of original, and course the piece was completed in.

Digital files

Submit a maximum of 20 pieces of your best creative work to the MCAD Merits Server. Please label your folder "Last Name, First Name". Jpeg files should not exceed 1 MB. Films should not exceed 5 minutes in length and be submitted via web link. Submit websites as URL addresses. **Submitted work must be from Foundation classes.**
