Verify Personal Information on Paylocity

Has your personal information changed? Did you move? Or simply curious what information we have on file? Log into Paylocity to verify and/or update your personal information. You can see your pay stubs there, too.

It's Winter In Minnesota: Sign Up For Alerts With Campus Safety

In case of closure due to weather, sign up for the free MCAD Emergency Text Message Service to get alerts about campus closures this winter. If that's not your style, you can still check local news outlets, the MCAD website, and keep an eye out on your email for messages from Public Safety.

How To Pay Guest Speakers

The Academic Affairs staff requires W-9 forms for guest speakers and other profession services from outside of MCAD. While working remotely, the W-9 form will be sent directly to the guest speakers by Academic Affairs through a secure online system. Please provide the email address of your guest speaker and the info about the event they will participate in the "Classroom Visiting Artists/Guest Speakers" section of the Payment Request Form. What about international guest speakers? Contact the Academic Affairs office at least 3 weeks prior to the event. This will ensure there's time to collect the necessary paperwork to process payments of honoraria per IRA requirements.
