## Requests for Spring 2021 Incomplete Grades Due Wednesday, May 12 at 5:00 p.m.

Requests for incomplete grades in Spring 2021 courses are due to Records no later than 5:00 p.m. on the last day of the semester, Wednesday, May 12. Please note that incomplete grades are only possible in certain circumstances, and that the incomplete grade policy has not changed in any way this academic year. Students who are currently on academic probation may not receive incomplete grades. See the <u>Student Handbook</u> for the full policy. Students must submit all incomplete work to faculty no later than Friday, September 24.

Students who are planning to request an incomplete but have not yet done so should contact their department chair or program director now to begin the approval process. Department chairs/program directors must approve any requests, and then the section faculty must do the same, before the approval is routed to Records. Forms are available on the <u>Records Intranet page</u>.

## December 2021 Intents to Graduate Due Wednesday, May 12

Intent to Graduate Forms for students planning to graduate in December 2021 are due Wednesday, May 12. Please remind any of your students and/or advisees who are planning for a December 2021 graduation date that they need to complete their Intent to Graduate forms on <u>myMCAD</u>.
