#### PRIORITY DEADLINES

#### Fall 2021 Add/Drop Period: 8/23-8/27 at 5:00 p.m.

Fall Semester 2021 Add/Drop will begin on Monday, August 23 and will end at 5:00 p.m. on Friday, August 27. Students may add and drop courses within this period, using the Add/Drop Courses Form that they can find on the Records Office tab of <u>myMCAD</u>. The form workflow will request department chair approval for all adds, and will also bring in Financial Aid if students will be reducing credits as a result of any drops. Verbal permission to add a course is not sufficient--all adds or drops must be completed using this form. This includes students who are waitlisted for sections and have faculty or chair approval to add the course. Review your course roster on <u>myMCAD</u> to determine if you have any waitlisted students, and contact your chair with any enrollment questions. **The deadline for students to submit Add/Drop Courses Forms is 5:00 p.m. on Friday, August 27.** *Forms will not be available on myMCAD after the deadline.* Course adds will not be permitted after the deadline, and course drops after the deadline will count as withdrawals, which remain on the record with a grade of W and involve a withdrawal fee.

**Continuing Education Fall Class Information** 



Continuing Education (CE) fall 2021 adult and teen courses are now open for registration! Classes begin September 9 and throughout the semester. Fall classes will be available both in-person and online.

Benefits eligible MCAD staff and faculty (and spouses) qualify for the Continuing Education tuition waiver, meaning they can take a non-credit class for only \$25 (plus any materials fees.) Once you have chosen the class you would like to take (view class catalog <u>here</u>), fill out the MCAD Tuition Waiver <u>Application</u>, submit it to <u>HR</u>, and we will place you on the waitlist once we receive the approved form. These spots are offered on a space-available basis so we will let you know if you get a seat 5 business days of the start of the class.

#### Media Center Reservation System Updates

The Media Center has updated their reservation systems for fall 2021! <u>Places and</u> <u>Spaces</u> will no longer include the darkrooms, but students, staff, and faculty will be able to gain access to the darkrooms if they're photo faculty, students will be able to access it if they've taken relevant darkroom courses.

Places and Spaces now includes two spaces for the Gray Studio! The small sweep has been added for everyone to reserve separately from the large sweep.

<u>Patron Portal</u> is back to normal, for the most part. You can make your own reservations that won't need approval from Media Center staff. However, patrons need to reserve their equipment at least 15 minutes ahead of time.

Kiosk computers have been returned to the Media Center! If you need to make a quick reservation, you can do so at the Media Center window.
