

In 2024 the Visual Arts Fund will award \$60,000 (six \$10,000 grants) to artist-organized projects in the Twin Cities metro region. The VAF supports the development of projects and initiatives that engage the public with visual art happening outside of established arts venues. **Submissions are due Saturday, September 28 by 5:00 pm CDT.**

Rhizome Microgrant Open Call

The Rhizome microgrant awards \$500-\$1500 USD for the creation of internet-based art for the following topics: Desktop Performance, Lost Web Histories, Natural Cycles, and Money as Medium.
