New Course Evaluation System

The college has implemented a new course evaluation software called EvaluationKit (EvalKit). This new system integrates with Canvas, providing notifications directly in the College's learning management system (LMS), streamlining the course eval development process, and opening opportunities for more flexible evaluations in the future. Instructors will have direct access to their evaluation reports, so you won't have to wait for PDFs to be emailed to you. Fill out an order form, send us your files, and we'll print them, charge your PaperCut account, and put them on the pickup shelf for you to grab whenever you want!

This is new for a lot of users. Previously the ImagePress was available as a public printer. That was a holdover from a bygone era and we've found over the last year that sending your files directly to us to print cuts down on mistakes, waste, and frustration.

If the ImagePress is selectable as a printing option on your computer you can still send your prints that way, but the preferred method is to email us your files.
