Training Video for Evaluation Kit

The college has implemented a new course evaluation software called EvaluationKit (EvalKit). This new system integrates with Canvas, providing notifications directly in the College's learning management system (LMS), streamlining the course eval development process, and opening opportunities for more flexible evaluations in the future.

One key change is that faculty and chairs/directors will have direct access to reports that they can customize based on the information they want.
