Announcements

Thanksgiving Break

Several campus offices will be closed or have reduced hours during the break. You can learn more about these changes here. Also, due to the safety of our community and limiting the spread of COVID-19, students who return home for Thanksgiving break are advised to not return to the MCAD campus for the final two weeks of the term. Faculty are to construct their syllabus to allow for the completion of student work remotely during the final two weeks of the term. COVID-19 Reporting Protocol

All members of the MCAD Community who are working, living, learning, or spending time on campus are required to notify MCAD if they are diagnosed with COVID-19. If someone is experiencing any symptoms of COVID-19, or believe they have had close contact with someone who has COVID-19, this person must:

- 1. Stay at home or in the campus apartment unit to isolate from others. Do not come to campus. Work or attend classes virtually if able to do so.
- 2. Call a primary health-care provider for further advice.
- 3. Students should notify <u>staysafestudents@mcad.edu</u>, which will email both Student Affairs and the COVID Coordinator. Students, with the assistance of Student Affairs if necessary,must notify their instructors to let them know that they are unable to attend an onsite class and/or feel unwell enough to complete online coursework.
- 4. Faculty and staff should report your absence as soon as is practicable to your supervisor and notify staysafestaff@mcad.edu.
- 5. Your health care provider and the Minnesota Department of Health will inform you of when you can safely return to campus. Once able to return to campus, you must seek final clearance from the Human Resources Case Manager for staff/faculty and Student Affairs Case Manager for students.
- 6. In all cases, confidentiality will be preserved in accordance with the law.
- 7. Protocols have been developed to make general notifications to areas responsible for sanitation, communication with impacted areas and modification of building access.

The Spring 2021 Syllabus Form is Live

The form to generate your syllabus(i) for next semester is ready to use. Some important things to keep in mind:

- Double check your course number. This is what generates the syllabus so if it's off, it'll have to be submitted again with the corrected number.
- As tempting as it is, avoid naming your Faculty Office Hour or Class Google Meet links. Naming them breaks the link after a while, so you'll have to recreate them and repost them.
- Syllabi are due the Friday before your class(es) begin.
